

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring / Reporting Violation
SURFACE WATER MONITORING, ROUTINE MAJOR**

The City of Beeville water system PWS ID 0130001 has violated the monitoring / reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems that treat surface water and / or ground water under the direct influence of surface water are required to submit monthly operating reports with operational data of the water provided to their customers.

We failed to monitor and / or report the following constituents chlorine.

This / These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s) August 2017.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe. We did not complete all monitoring / reporting for surface water constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The City of Beeville has contracted Inframark Company to oversee the distribution system. This includes coliform sampling, flushing hydrants and daily chlorine residuals at designated locations outlined in the monitoring plan.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
