Animal Control:

Animal control officers will continue to respond to emergency and high priority calls that include law enforcement assistance (injured/sick stray animals; cruelty and neglect complaints; bite complaints; and dangerous/aggressive dog complaints). Low priority/non-emergency activity will be limited. Our shelter will reduce intakes especially non-emergency owner surrender intakes.

Beeville Police Department

The Communications Office at the main Police Department located at 402 North Washington will remain operational on a 24/7 basis. An intercom system has been installed to allow the citizens to speak with our Communications staff. An officer will be notified and will meet the citizen outside.

The Beeville Police Training Center (temporary police headquarters) located at 608 West Milam will remain operational Monday – Friday 8 a.m. -5 p.m. An intercom system has been installed to allow the citizens to speak with staff.
